Prior to the Officers arrival, Officers were advised by radio dispatch that the OF-01 was driving a 2017 black in color Volkswagen Jetta, also that the OF-01 was an active criminal gang member (Sur 13) and, had three active criminal warrant (#MJMAG2312605, #MJMAG2312606, #MJMAG2314130) for his arrest from the El Paso Police Department.

Officers were also advised via radio by Officer F. Castillo #3454 that he located the OF-01's vehicle on the West side of the apartment complex near possibly building "D." Officer Castillo drove and passed the DEFENDANT who was inside a 2017 black on color Volkswagen Jetta bearing Texas plates of #NPH3733. Officer Castillo then made a U-Turn and parked in back of OF-01's vehicle.
