On February 8, 2024 Officers L. Castro #3380 and C. Gadra #2461 while working as uniformed patrol 1F168, were dispatched to 4554 Hercules Apt #46 in reference to a verbal family violence call. Prior to the Officers arrival, Officers were advised by radio dispatch that the OF-01 was driving a 2017 black in color Volkswagen Jetta, also that the OF-01 was an active criminal gang member (Sur 13) and, had three active criminal warrant (#MJMAG2312605, #MJMAG2312606, #MJMAG2314130) for his arrest from the El Paso Police Department.

Officers were also advised via radio by Officer F. Castillo #3454 that he located the OF-01's vehicle on the West side of the apartment complex near possibly building "D." Officer Castillo drove and passed the DEFENDANT who was inside a 2017 black on color Volkswagen Jetta bearing Texas plates of #NPH3733. Officer Castillo then made a U-Turn and parked in back of OF-01's vehicle. As Officer Castillo was driving behind the OF-01's vehicle, OF-01 began to drive forward (North of the Apt complex) therefore, Officer Payan drove towards OF-01 (Front) and blocked the apartment complex roadway, in order for the OF-01 not be able to drive forward or backwards. OF-01 placed his vehicle in reverse and drove through the the open apartment complex area, and collided with a metal barrier (located inside the apartment complex). Camp continued walking towards OF-01, and stated to him “drop the handgun... we do not want to hurt you... no one will get hurt.” OF-01 was observed to continue crying and not wanting to drop the handgun, OF-01 then began to give his farewells to the people he love including his dog. Sgt. Camp then continued walking towards OF-01 and Officers Castillo and Castro walked at a wider angle on both sides of Sgt. Camp (Officer Castillo standing on left side, Castro on right side). 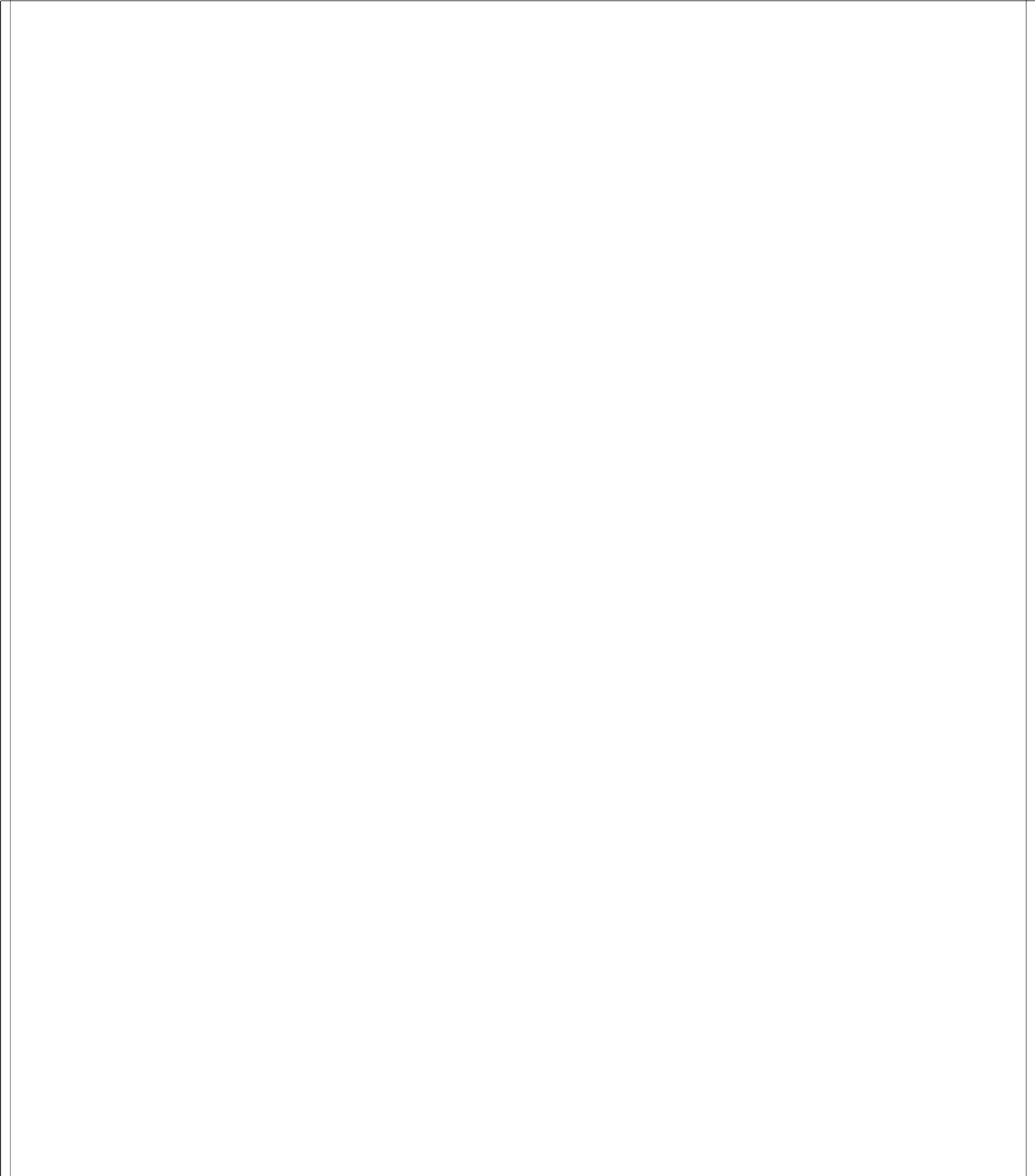
